### **SERMON NOTES**

Note 1: Why doesn't that one miracle happen? that one I have been waiting for, that one I have been praying for.

Note 2: **Psalm 86:10** 

"For you are great and do great miracles. You alone are God."

- Note 3: Don't let the one miracle that is not happening keep you from seeing the many miracles that God wants to be doing in your life.
- Note 4: In order to see more miracles, live with tenacity (persistence and determination, holding tightly).

  Have the tenacity to go all the way to Jordan!
- Note 5: Moses was **forty years** out in the wilderness, before he saw the Red Sea split.

Joshua served Moses as an apprentice for his **entire lifetime**, before he saw the walls of Jericho come tumbling down.

Peter walked with Jesus for **three years**, before he preached and three thousand people were saved.

Paul was beaten and had stones thrown at him, was almost killed, before he had the vision of heaven.

Note 6: In order to see more miracles, live with the tenacity of having faith when you don't feel like having faith.

Live with the tenacity of hanging on to the last thread of hope that you have and NOT GIVING UP.

Live with the tenacity of coming back to faith again and again and again.
