"When You Face a Crisis" Pas

Note 1: 2 Chronicles 20:1 "After this, the Moabites and the Ammonites with some of the Minuites... came to make war on Jehoshaphat."

Note 2: 2 Chronicles 20:3 "King Jehoshaphat sought to <u>inquire of the Lord</u>, and he proclaimed a fast for all Judah."

Note 3: Fasting clears your mind and heightens your sensitivity, because your blood is flowing to your brain rather than to your stomach.

Note 4: 2 Chronicles 20: 6, 7, 12

King Jehoshaphat went and stood before them and he prayed aloud: "You are powerful and mighty... You gave the land to the descendants of Abraham...You are our God! Punish this large army that is attacking us."

Note 5: 2 Chronicles 20:12

"We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on You."

Note 6: 2 Chronicles 20:21

"Jehoshaphat appointed men to sing to the Lord and to praise Him for the splendor of His holiness as they went out at the head of the army saying 'Give thanks to the Lord...'"

Note 7: 2 Chronicles 20:22

"As they began to sing and to praise, the Lord set ambushes against the men of Ammon, Moab and Mount Seir who were invading Judah and they were defeated."
