### **SERMON NOTES**

Note 1: Exodus 15:22

"Then Moses led Israel from the Red Sea and they went into the desert of Shur. For three days they traveled into the desert without finding water."

Note 2: Exodus 15:23

When they came to Marah, they could not drink its water because it was bitter, that is why the place is called Marah."

Note 3: After every mountaintop in life, there is always a valley.

Note 5: A big service (sacrifice) is often followed by forgetfulness.
