SERMON NOTES

Note 1: What makes us happy? Youth?
From preteens, our sense of happiness starts going down.
In our forties, our sense of happiness hits the bottom.
Then, from our fifties, our sense of happiness starts going up.

Note 2: Four happiness killers: pain, people, pressure, and problems.

Note 3: "We are not in heaven yet, and these bad things happen on this earth. I put my life in God's hands and trust that God has BEST INTERESTES at heart. And I have clung to my faith more than ever this year. As a consequence, I have not lost my joy."

Note 4: Genesis 3:11-12

The Lord God said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree that I commanded you not to eat from?" The man said, "The woman you put here with me – she gave me some fruit from the tree, and I ate it."

Note 5: We are always blaming somebody else for our unhappiness.

Note 6: God even takes all of your mistakes and puts those into his plan. And God can use all of your problems too:

- 1) God can use your problem to draw you closer to God.
- 2) God can use your problem to <u>draw you closer to the people</u> around you.
- 3) God can use your problem to <u>make you more like Jesus</u>.
